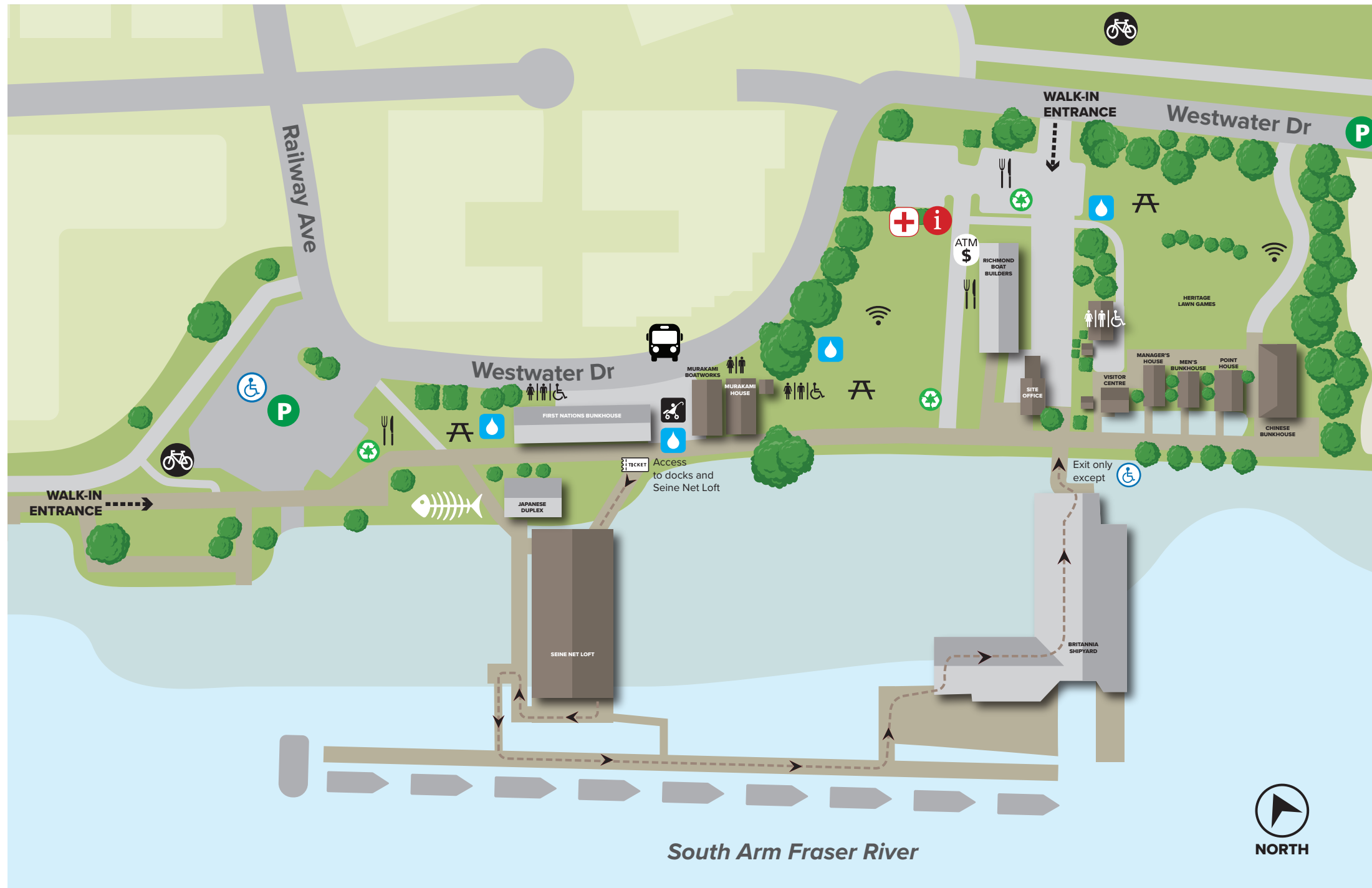

While most of Britannia Shipyards is accessible, some heritage buildings have doors that may be too narrow for some wider wheelchairs.  
Due to the tides, the ramps to the docks are very steep during the day. Wheelchair access is only available from 5-6 pm.  
The Shipyards Building and Seine Net Loft are accessible to wheelchairs all day.
-  Keep this heritage site clean and use the Zero Waste Stations. You are also invited to refill your own water bottle at the water stations on site.
-  Stroller Parking  
Due to steep ramps, strollers are not allowed onto the dock. Please park them at the stroller parking before going into the Seine Net Loft.
